

Fat Biking was called “the hot, new winter sport” by Forbes in 2016.

With tires up to 5 inches across these bikes can float across snow, offering an alternative method of outdoor exercise during the colder months of the year when conditions aren't perfect for traditional winter activities.

Great Glen - Gorham, NH is open daily all season long as conditions allow.

Bretton Woods - groomed Fatbike trails as well as rentals all winter long.

MWV Ski Touring Center - The Mt. Washington Valley Ski Touring & Snowshoe Center is the first Nordic network in our area to allow Fat Bike riders to use network trails in Whitaker Woods.

Echo Lake State Park - Echo Lake/Cathedral Lake State Park are connected to the White Mountain National Forest by a snowmobile trail. (Red's Trail) Other areas to be packed are The Hemlock Lane trailhead near the Walmart, the Pudding Pond Conservation Area and Marshall Conservation Land off West Side Road.

Moose Brook State Park and the Presidential Rail Trail - 18-miles of trail currently administered by the New Hampshire Division of Parks and Recreation. Permitted uses on the PRT are: hiking, biking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, snowmobiling and mushing.
