



## Student Debt Assistance

**STAY MWV's** mission is to attract and retain a vibrant and engaged young professional presence in the Mt Washington Valley. By providing student debt assistance to our region's young professionals, we hope to break down the financial barriers faced by young people wanting to place permanent roots down in the MWV.

### Application Details

- The STAY MWV Student Debt Assistance will provide up to \$3,000 in student loan repayment to selected applicants.
- Deadline to submit the assistance application is Friday May 15, 2020.
- The Assistance Committee reserves the right to request in-person interviews in the weeks between May 15<sup>th</sup> and May 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
- Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed.

**Please note:** Assistance funds will be disbursed directly to the loan company. *The recipient will work directly with STAY MWV to facilitate this process by providing their social security number, the address of the student loan management company and the account number to which the funds should be dispersed. Any assistance dollars awarded are considered income. Therefore, the recipient will receive a 1099 before the end of January 2021. Granite State or White Mountain Community College Scholarships are not taxable.*

### Assistance Applicant Criteria

- Applicant must be working in the Mt. Washington Valley (NH/ME).
- Applicant must show proof of responsible borrowing and must be in good standing with the company holding the loan.
- The recipient of STAY MWV's assistance will either participate in Leadership MWV 2021 (scholarship provided) or otherwise assist the fundraising efforts of STAY MWV for the following year. This includes the recipients of our sponsored assistance programs (Mountain Garden Club, Conway Area Lion's Club, etc).
- Please note that the STAY MWV assistance award cannot be awarded to anyone employed by or related to the MWV Chamber of Commerce, MWV Preservation Association, or STAY MWV or those who are in the 2020 Leadership MWV Class. This is not applicable to sponsored assistance programs as any assistance awarded by STAY MWV's partners are subject to criteria determined by their own assistance award committees and may or may not be subject to the rules above.

## Application Process

In addition to a completed application, please also submit the following:

- Cover Letter addressed to the Assistance Committee including the following:
  - Why you have chosen to live and work in the Mt. Washington Valley?
  - Positive and negative aspects of living in the Valley
  - How can we, as young people, best affect positive change in the MWV?
  - What are your professional goals and how will this assistance help you achieve those goals?
- A current resume
- Proof of loan balance (most recent statement)
- Two professional letters of recommendation one of which should be from the applicant's Mount Washington Valley job supervisor. If self-employed, provide a letter of recommendation from a MWV resident or business familiar with your work.

## **Additional Assistance and Scholarships**

Several other respected organizations in the Mt. Washington Valley have recognized the need to support young professionals in our region. To this end, they have allocated a portion of their scholarship dollars to go towards the student debt assistance award. Below is information regarding these scholarships and assistance awards. **Granite State College Scholarship: Certificate for 3 Credit Course**

### **North Conway Rotary Club Assistance Award: \$1,000**

The North Conway Rotary Club is a Mt. Washington Valley Service Club serving our community with international efforts in health and education.

**Check this box IF:**

- You would like to be considered for an additional scholarship from the North Conway Rotary Club. If so, you must submit an additional essay describing how you exemplify the Rotary Club values of "Service Above Self". The essay should address your previous involvement in, and passion for, community service.

### **Mountain Garden Club Assistance Award: \$1,000**

This grant is for a graduate of a post-secondary education program employed in the Mount Washington Valley in the areas of: agriculture, environmental science, environmental conservation, horticulture, floriculture, landscape design, botany, forestry, habitat or forest systems ecology, land management and/or other related allied subjects. The recipient of the \$3,000 STAY MWV Assistance Award is not eligible to receive the MGC Student Loan Assistance Award in the same year as the STAY MWV Assistance Award. All applications will be submitted to the MGC Scholarship Committee for review and final decision.

**Check this box IF:**

- You fulfill the description above and would like to be considered for the Mountain Garden Club Student Loan Assistance Grant.

### **Conway Area Lion's Club Assistance Award: \$1,000**

This award is for a graduate of a post-secondary education program employed in the Mount Washington Valley in the medical/health care field, with special consideration given to those employed in vision or hearing care. The recipient of the \$3,000 STAY MWV Assistance is not eligible to receive the CALC Student Loan Assistance Award in the same year as the STAY MWV Assistance Award. All applications will be submitted to the CALC Assistance Committee for review and final decision.

**Check this box IF:**

- You fulfill the description above and would like to be considered for the Conway Area Lion's Club Student Loan Assistance Grant.

**Kiwanis Club Assistance Award: \$1,000**

The mission of the Kiwanis Club of the Mountain Washington Valley is to make our community a better place in which to live by engaging adult and youth volunteers to support community service projects with an emphasis on the needs of our children.

**Check this box IF:**

- You hold a valid teaching certification and are employed as an educator in the MWV area SAU 9, MSAD 72 or a private educational institution.
