Participants have action assignments that may include information interviews with local leaders, outside reading assignments and the development and completion of a fundraising plan to raise a minimum of \$3,000 for the Stay & Thrive MWV mission.

Outside assignments are designed to encourage involvement beyond the classroom. Including the development of community mentors and community members. Students will have the opportunity to network with civic leaders who may assist personal and professional growth in the future.

Participants are asked to outline their personal learning and community goals and to track progress on these goals throughout the program.

Attendance: Success of the program depends on participant attendance; attendance at each session is expected. To graduate, participants **must miss no more than 2 sessions** and provide advanced notification of sessions that will not be attended. Due to space and insurance considerations, participants may not bring dependents to the program sessions.

Tuition Fee is \$500. Leadership MWV urges employers to support participants by providing tuition assistance. A \$100 deposit is due immediately upon acceptance into the program. The remaining tuition is due before the first course session December 11, 2019. Program costs are incurred in advance; therefore, tuition fees are non-refundable.
